Approved that Division S would be split into 3 Divisions - Divisions B, D & S wef 1 July 1995.

May 1998 District Council Meeting, Kuching

Approved that Hong Kong join District 51. Hong Kong became part of District 51 as Area T3, Division T.

May 1999 District Council Meeting, Singapore

Approved that a new division be formed for Hong Kong. Division H came into effect 1 July 1999.
 Approved that a Mandarin Division be formed for Mandarin Clubs in Singapore, Johor Bahru, Malacca & Penang. Division M came into effect 01 July 1999. The Mandarin Clubs in Singapore came from Division S.

Nov 1999 Semi-Annual District Council Meeting, Thailand

Endorsement for Macau and Brunei to join District 51. Macau to be in Division H (Hong Kong) and Brunei to be in Division K (Sabah, Malaysia).

May 2001 District Council Meeting, Hong Kong

Council informed of approval by TI Board of Directors that Macau and Brunei be included in District 51 wef. 1 July 2001.

May 2002 District Council Meeting, Kuala Lumpur

1) Approved that Division M be split into Division L (for Mandarin Clubs in Singapore) and Division M (for Mandarin Clubs in Johor Bahru, Malacca, Kuala Lumpur and Penang).

"Conducting Quality Contests" - A report on the First Education & Training (E & T) Task Force Project on 7th August 2004

On August 7th at Clementi CC Seminar Room, approximately 110 Toastmasters and friends are gathered for an afternoon of scintillating speeches, brilliant wit and breathtaking analysis of speech techniques, ideas and presentation skills.

"**Conducting Quality Contests**" is a workshop conceived by the Education & Training Task Force, a group of volunteer Toastmasters who came forward to support LGET Professor Dr Khong Chooi Peng's efforts in fulfilling the District's Education Goals.... and much more.

This workshop exceeded the expectations of many Toastmasters. The "X" factor, which made the workshop memorable, was seen in the design of this workshop.

One of the training modules recommended by Toastmasters International is to guide members for the upcoming contest season. But the methodology determines the extent participants can be entertained and educated at the same time, beyond the monotony of the stone-cold contest rules and regulations.

The Core Organizing Team comprised Division Z Governor Goh Wei Koon ATMS, Dr Khong DTM, Dr Nimmi Agnes Jayathurai (Task Force Project Coordinator) CTM and Jackson Chua CTM, Division U Governor. Members of other Divisions came forward to help out on the actual day.

Drawing inspiration from the popular television show "American Idol" the E&T Team divided the workshop into two sessions. The first session was an update of the latest contest rules and a sharing of the experience in delivering a Quality Contest. The second session was a gem: Three test speakers presented three speeches and 'a panel of judges gave feedback and shared their insights and perspectives on specific areas such as structure, stage technique, speech value and language use.

The success of this event was due largely to the speakers and judges who were invited to participate in this event – Toastmasters who are competent, technically accomplished and engaging personalities in their own right. And it is small wonder that history was made at this event.

The speaker in the first session was none other **Ho Fong Ming** DTM, the IPDG of District 51. In the second session, **John Sih** DTM, Past District Champion and 1st Runner Up Regional Winner, **Ramesh Muthusamy** ATMB, **Wekie Tay DTM** and **Ng Seng Chuan** ATMG were the Judges who shared their insightful comments on the speeches presented by test speakers **Violet Lim** CTM, **Kan Kin Fung** DTM and **Kenneth Tan** CTM.

The highlight of the workshop was the scintillating speeches delivered by the test speakers and judges. Their performances and thoughtful insights laced with natural wit and humour made learning fun and captivated the audience.

The Team is grateful to **Clementi Toastmasters Club** for providing the venue, to Toastmasters who gave valuable suggestions, feedback and assistance, and to everyone who contributed in one way or another to the success of the Workshop.







Two events were planned to celebrate the launch of District 80. The first was a Boot Camp for Toastmasters presented by Darren LaCroix during the afternoon of July 10, 2004. This event was followed by a banquet later that same day.

Presenter's Boot Camp

Participants of the Boot Camp were inspired by the videos that Darren showed of his preparation for the World Championship. The videos documented how Darren continually improved his speech content and delivery through practice and feedback in preparation for the World Championship.

The participants of this workshop included Toastmasters from Hong Kong, Macau, Thailand and Singapore who were joined by Toastmasters from Malaysia and Indonesia. This event was indeed a fitting celebration of the launch of District 80.

Banquet

To celebrate the launch of District 80, a banquet was held on the same evening. The Guest of Honour was Mr. Chan Soo Sen, MINISTER OF STATE FOR EDUCATION & COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT AND SPORTS. He enthralled the audience with his public speaking skills by using both Mandarin and English to deliver his speech to the Toastmasters.

The District Governor of District 51 2004-2005 Dr. A. Arulnathan, DTM and the Immediate Past District Governor Ho Fong Meng, DTM together with Toastmasters from District 51 joined in the celebration with the District Officers and Toastmasters from District 80.

The highlights of the celebration included a Lion Dance, and speeches by Mr. Chan Soo Sen and Darren LaCroix. This event provided opportunities for fellowship between the Toastmasters of Districts 51 and 80.
